

Privacy Policy For The World University

The World University is dedicated to protecting the privacy of all members, faculty, consulting faculty, students, associated and affiliated organizations. This Privacy Statement explains how the World University collects, uses and discloses personal information.

Information Collection: The World University may collect information that is required for membership applications, faculty and consulting faculty applications, student applications for courses offered, applications for associate or affiliate school status, application for Cultural Doctorate status, requests for purchase of courses or for products from the World University Bookstore. This information may include name, address, phone numbers, email address, resumes, biographical information, educational history, employment history and data on humanitarian efforts. Financial data may be required in certain cases, as in application for scholarships, or in cases where credit card numbers and expiration dates are used for purchase of products, courses or for donations. In all cases this data is kept highly confidential and is used strictly for the purpose that it is intended.

Disclosure of Information: Information will be shared among Board members and with staff members as necessary in order to process applications and requests. Personal data will be released to third parties only in the case of a person or organization's express written request.

Mailings: The World University will mail a periodic Journal to all members, which may contain personal information about authors who contribute to the news letter. Members may opt out of these communications verbally or in writing to the World University and no one will be pressured to contribute, although articles are appreciated and welcomed. World University will not sell or given away mailing lists, and such lists may not be given away, sold, nor purchased by any other organization or persons.

Legal Disclaimer: Though the World University makes every effort to protect member's privacy, we may need to disclose personal information when required by law, to comply with a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process served on our organization.

Third Party Intermediaries: The World University may use an outside shipping company to ship orders and a credit card processing company to bill members for purchase of products, courses or donations. These companies may not retain, share, store or use personally identifiable information for any secondary purposes.

Surveys: From time to time, the World University may request information from members via surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary and members who chose to participate are not required to disclose personal contact information. No identifying information will be disclosed in tabulating the results of surveys.

Correcting/ Updating/ Deleting Personal Information: If a member requests to change personal information (such as address, phone, email, etc.) or if a member requests to change membership status or cancel membership, please contact the World University Desert Sanctuary Campus.

Notification of Changes: If the World University decides to revise the Privacy Statement, this will be posted in our newsletter, on our website, and any other places we deem appropriate, so that our members are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it and under what circumstances, if any, we disclose it.
